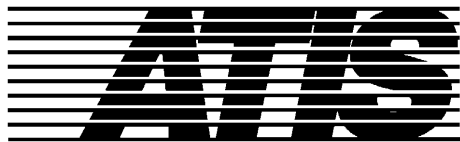

Subject: Lawful Intercept Specifications for UMTS Release 5

Dear Mr. McKibben:

Our recent review of the 3GPP SA3-LI plans and deliverables for UMTS Release 5 on the IMCN Subsystem Multi-Media Domain indicate Requirements and Stage 2 specifications for the Network Elements (NEs) to Delivery Function (DF) interfaces (ref: 33.106 V5.0.0 and 33.107 V5.0.0) are being developed for 3GPP. However, we note that specifications for the capabilities between the DF and Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) are not being addressed at this time.

In order to ensure capabilities for delivering Content and Intercept Related Information (IRI) to the LEAs are defined within 3GPP and thus available for use by its partners, we request 3GPP SA3-LI to address the DF-LEA interfaces and develop stage 1, stage 2, and stage 3 specifications detailing appropriate capabilities to address Lawful Intercept regulatory requirements in North America [ref: Communication Assistance for Law Enforcement Act (CALEA) 1994].
