1 Introduction

The **udepcolor** package has been designed with the purpose of providing simple and efficient access to the institutional and corporate color palette of the University of Piura (UDEP) within the \LaTeX system.

The colors have been selected and implemented using the `xcolor` package and following the brand and visual identity guidelines of the University of Piura.

2 Installation and use

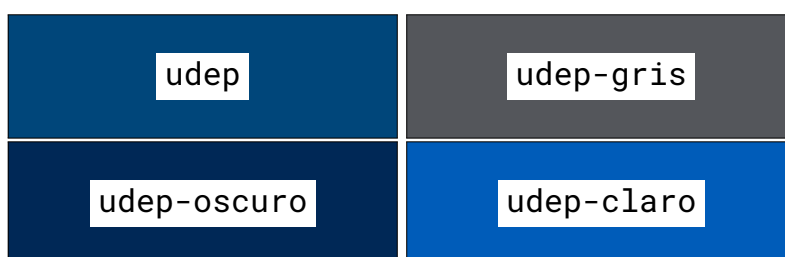
To install the **udepcolor** package download and unzip the `udepcolor.sty` file and place it in a folder accessible to \LaTeX (this can be the current working folder or a subfolder in the TEXMF directory).

To use the **udepcolor** package add the following command to the preamble of your document: `usepackage{udepcolor}`

3 Available colors

3.1 Institutional colors

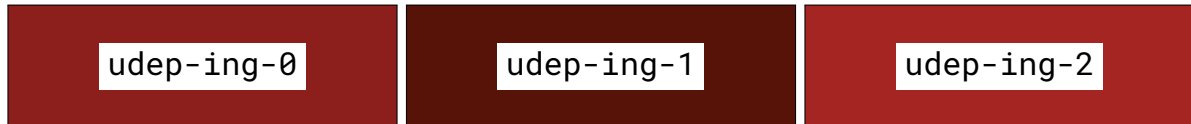
The **udepcolor** package defines the 4 institutional colors: `udep`, `udep-gris`, `udep-oscuro` and `udep-claro`.



3.2 Corporate colors

The 3 colors corresponding to each faculty have been defined according to the following naming convention: `udep-fac-n` where `fac` is a 3-letter identifier, unique for each faculty and `n` is a number that can be 0, 1 or 2.

For example, for the faculty of Engineering, its unique identifier would be `ing` being the 3 colors available: `udep-ing-0`, `udep-ing-1` and `udep-ing-2`.
